



FISCAL COURT ORDER  
DECLARATION OF LOCAL STATE OF EMERGENCY

On motion by Larry Randolph, and second by Marty Chandler,

With all 5 members voting in favor, the motion passed.

The record is ordered to reflect that, pursuant to KRS 67.078, the Simpson County Fiscal Court finds that an emergency exists as follows: a severe winter storm event occurred during the week of February 16, resulting in numerous unplanned expenses related to additional manpower, supplies & materials necessary to respond, additionally, significant building maintenance repairs were incurred as a result of this event, all of which requires a budget ordinance amending the existing budget by \$99,500, to allow for necessary purchases & expenditures; ordinances are required to have publication and two readings before becoming effective, which would be impossible to do to allow for purchases to be made and repairs be completed; therefore, this emergency order will bypass the publication and two readings provision of the ordinance statutes and make said ordinance effective immediately upon passage by the Fiscal Court.
