At a special-called meeting of the Simpson County Fiscal Court held in the County Courtroom of the Simpson County Historic Courthouse on January 19th, 2012 at 9:00 AM.

Judge Henderson called the meeting to order with Blake Tarpley leading in prayer followed by the pledge to the American flag.

Sheriff Chris Cline and Chief Deputy Jacky Hunt met with Fiscal Court to work through the 2012 budget for the sheriff's department. The discussion included anticipated revenues and projected expenses for a budget with twenty employees including court security.

Motion by Chandler Second by Tarpley Ayes-All

Approve the 2012 Sheriff's budget as submitted with a \$5,000 increase in the fuel line item with the condition that the General Budget will support a fiscal court contribution of \$458,300 to the sheriff's budget.

Motion by Randolph Second by Chandler Ayes-All


Acknowledge that the approved 2012 sheriff's budget does not allow for an increase in the number of full-time employees in the sheriff's department.

Motion by Tarpley Second by Banton Ayes-All

Pursuant to KRS 64.530(3), approve the annual order setting maximum lump sum amount of \$862,200 for deputies and assistants during the calendar of 2012, with that of full-time salaries and wages at \$490,000, overtime wages at \$40,000, health insurance at \$115,200, employer's match social security/non-hazardous duty retirement at \$67,000 and employer's share hazardous duty retirement at \$150,000.
