At a regular meeting of the Simpson County Fiscal Court held in the Fiscal Court Meeting Room in the Simpson County Historic Courthouse, May 2, 2017, at 8:30 AM

Judge Henderson called the meeting to order and Magistrate Tarpley opened the meeting with prayer followed by the pledge of allegiance to the American flag.

As statutorily required, Judge Executive Jim Henderson presented the proposed \$12,024,429 FY17-18 Budget to Fiscal Court. Judge Henderson led the discussion as Fiscal Court reviewed the budget and feedback was offered by court members for the final draft. This is the first balanced budget without carryover since 2008 and consists of \$6,224,858 for General, \$1,481,383 for Road, \$4,021,318 for Jail, \$110,170 for LGEA and \$186,700 for 911 funds

Fire Rescue Chief Leslie Goodrum presented information regarding fire protection with an automatic aid agreement versus the current mutual aid agreement for residents near county lines. This discussion was addressing Simpson County residents in the northern part of the county adjacent to the Woodburn area. An automatic aid agreement between Franklin Simpson Fire Rescue and Woodburn Volunteer Fire Department would mean that Woodburn volunteer firefighters would automatically be paged out to structure fires in Simpson County within five road miles of that Woodburn station. ISO does not recognize mutual aid and, therefore, residents who have insurance with companies that use ISO ratings to determine home owner's premiums are often higher because ISO considers these areas essentially unprotected. Under an automatic aid agreement with Warren County, residents in this area would be required to pay a \$50 annual fee but residents could opt out of such an agreement and be billed for costs of Woodburn responding to a call on their property. Areas adjacent to Plano and Auburn will be looked at separately under different agreements at a later date. Magistrates will consider information from this discussion and prepare to make a recommendation at a future meeting. Chief Goodrum would like to have an automatic aid agreement in place before the next ISO review. Both Simpson and Warren County fiscal courts would have to approve such an agreement.

Mark Welch, representing the Rural and Municipal Aid division of the Kentucky Transportation Cabinet, visited with Fiscal Court. He serves a thirty-three county area from Barren County west. Both the County Road Aid and Rural and Secondary Roads programs are under this division of the KYTC.

Judge Henderson reported that the Administrative Office of the Courts (AOC) has been in the state news recently due to improprieties in the standards by which disposal of surplus property was conducted. An AOC employee in the midst of these allegations deals directly with Simpson County Fiscal Court and has been the go-to-person for business related to the Simpson County Justice Center maintenance expense approvals. The judge said that a Simpson County Justice Project Development Board meeting is scheduled here Wednesday, May 3rd, to select a financial advisor for the proposed \$2.3 million project.

Judge Henderson reported that State Treasurer Allison Ball came to the Simpson County Historic Courthouse to visit with citizens on April 26th. One of the talking points during her visit was a relatively new website, transparency ky.gov., which provides transparency of state government. Ms. Ball hopes to partner with other levels of government to provide links which can make their information available through this site as well. Judge Henderson indicated that he is in favor of participating in this initiative and will be looking into integrating software with their office to do so. Another topic of interest was discussion of the unclaimed property division of the treasurer's office.

Emergency Management Director Bob Palmer announced that a Community Emergency Training will be held at Franklin Medical Center Thursday evening.
