Judge Barnes reported at this time there have been 36 confirmed cases of the COVID-19 in Simpson County reported by the Barren River Regional Health Department with 25 of those having recovered and two deaths leaving a count of nine cases currently active. He also reported that according to the guidelines from Governor Beshear, retail businesses that has been closed during the pandemic may re-open May 20th. His report also included changes for voting in the primary election due to the COVID-19 Pandemic. There are three options for voting in this year's primary. Voters may request mail-in ballots from the County Clerk's office, early in-person voting may be conducted by appointment weekdays June 8th thru June 22nd at the Historic Courthouse or in-person voting on Election Day for ALL precincts will be from 6 AM until 6 PM at the Historic Courthouse.

Judge Barnes announced the special-called Fiscal Court meeting which will include the Public Hearing for CRA & LGEA Funds scheduled for Friday, May 22nd at 8:30 AM.

Fiscal Court was presented another revision of the budget to reflect the last discussion of the proposed FY20-21 Simpson County budget. The budget will be put into the official format of FY20-21 Budget Ordinance No. 220.214 for first reading at the special-called fiscal court meeting Friday, May 22nd at 8:30 AM.

Magistrate Chandler commended the road crew as they've started mowing and encouraged folks to support local businesses as re-openings begin.

Set a speed limit of 25 mph and post a speed-limit sign on Spence Lane, a dead-end street, after a resident of the street requested the action for safety reasons.

Magistrate Thurman reported that spray painting is expanding from Kummer Road onto Andrews, Caudill and Springfield roads as well. Public Works Director Bobby Groves said that he and his crew had witnessed this activity recently while working in the area. Magistrate Thurman would like to see signage addressing the illegal parking on the roadway and on private property as well as the painting and littering on the road. Director Groves recommended that if signs are posted, there be fines attached for violations. Sheriff Hopson reported his department does about ten patrols a day through the area but obviously cannot be there all of the time. Magistrate Thurman will work with Sheriff Hopson and Director Groves to determine a plan of action to address the issue in the area.

Director Groves also reported that a landowner at Saddler Ford area might be receptive to discussion of a designated parking area and he suggested signage on the Warren County side might force parking to the other side and help alleviate the obstruction of the traffic flow. During this discussion Director Groves reported that county-wide vandalism and theft of signs, both road name signs and stop signs, have drastically increased to the point that his \$10,000 budget for signs this year will likely be close to \$13,000 by the end of this fiscal year and he estimated \$9,000 of this is due to vandalism.

Attorney Sam Phillips reported that the extended deadline to May 15th for collection of 2019 property taxes has now passed and they are now officially delinquent and at the County Clerk's office until time for the tax sale in August. Taxpayers and sheriff's staff were commended on this year's 98.65% collection rate.
