At a regular meeting of the Simpson County Fiscal Court held in the Courtroom of the Simpson County Historic Courthouse, Tuesday, December 15, 2020, at 8:30 AM

County Judge Executive Mason Barnes called the fiscal court meeting to order and Magistrate Poston opened with prayer followed by the pledge to the American flag. This meeting was streamed live on Facebook to maintain compliance with the measures associated with the COVID-19 pandemic.

Fiscal Court acknowledged the presentation of Sheriff Jere Dee Hopson's proposed 2021 budget with fuel and firing range amounts to be increased before his official and final budget presentation at the January 5<sup>th</sup> fiscal court meeting. The annual order setting the maximum amount for the sheriff's deputies and assistants must also be approved at that time.

Approve the November 30, 2020 Financial Statement subject to audit and authorize signatures of Judge Executive Barnes and Treasurer Nicole Law.

Judge Barnes report began with acknowledgement of receipt of a reimbursement check of \$388.00 from PVA Alison Cummings to Fiscal Court since the PVA Fall Conference was virtual this year due to the COVID pandemic and all of the allocation from Fiscal Court was not needed as well as a small refund from their inspection ad. Judge Barnes took this opportunity to express appreciation to magistrates as half of their first terms, except for Marty Chandler who is in the middle of his fourth term, is approaching. He also commended the court on being progressive in hiring a fourth employee to assist in the Fiscal Court and Planning and Zoning offices. He continued by thanking his staff, department heads and their staffs and elected officials and their staffs for their services and wished everyone a Merry Christmas and Happy New Year as did each of the magistrates and the county attorney.

Magistrate Chandler again expressed his concern about the safety hazard when tractor trailers hauling grains to the hatchery are lined up periodically in the turning lane as well as on the sides of 31W South, at times simultaneously, as they approach the entrance to Tyson Foods at 3150 Nashville Road creating areas of impaired visibility on this major thoroughfare. The consensus of the court was for a letter to be sent to Tyson by community officials such as Judge Barnes and perhaps Mayor Dixon regarding this problem.

Magistrate Poston expressed appreciation for the new community Christmas tree and the recent tree lighting ceremony as well as the Kiwanis Christmas parade that was held this past weekend.

County Attorney Sam Phillips encouraged everyone to pay property taxes by the end of December to avoid the additional charges of penalties and interest.

Emergency Management Director Robert Palmer reported that he is involved in the coordination efforts in Simpson County and within the region to administer the Pfizer COVID-19 vaccine which has been delivered to eleven hospitals in Kentucky with Medical Center Franklin being one of the contractors to be vaccinating those to receive the vaccine first such as first responders and healthcare workers in this community but not all of these folks will be vaccinated at the same time. A couple of the larger pharmacies will be administering the vaccine to the long-term care facilities. It is expected to be on into 2021 before the vaccine will be available to the general population.
