At a regular meeting of the Simpson County Fiscal Court held in the Courtroom of the Simpson County Historic Courthouse, Tuesday, January 19, 2021, at 8:30 AM

County Judge Executive Mason Barnes called the fiscal court meeting to order and Facilities Maintenance Supervisor Bill Rohrs opened with prayer followed by the pledge to the American flag. This meeting was streamed live on Facebook to maintain compliance with the measures associated with the COVID-19 pandemic.

Facilities Maintenance Supervisor Bill Rohrs and 49<sup>th</sup> Judicial Circuit Judge Janet Crocker reported on the completion of the Simpson County Justice Center Capital Construction Project No.1693 which addressed a water infiltration problem presenting soon after the building was completed in 2004. This project has corrected those issues which were a result of poor construction practices particularly in the areas of the roof and FRP application. During the renovation process at the request of Mr. Rohrs and Judge Crocker other matters such as the addition of a generator, canopies over entrances and enhanced notification, monitoring and control capabilities of equipment, either within the scope of this project or with other funding available from revenue generated from court system fees, were accomplished. Judge Executive Mason Barnes as well as the two previous county judge executives, during their respective terms, and Judge Crocker have served as members of the Project Development Board along with AOC representative, Danny Rhoades during this project. Monthly PDB meetings were held throughout the project and appreciation was expressed to all who had been involved. Judge Crocker reiterated that the project was funded by the state legislature and that no funding was provided from the county's general fund. Judge Barnes and Judge Crocker commended Mr. Rohrs' involvement and oversight of this project. Judge Barnes also expressed his appreciation to Judge Crocker for her years of service as the circuit judge for Simpson and Allen counties as she has announced her retirement effective January 31, 2021.

Approve December 31, 2020 Financial Statement subject to audit and authorize signatures of Treasurer Nicole Law and Judge Executive Mason Barnes.

Judge Barnes reported that he had participated in the Human Rights Commission motorcade held honoring the life of Martin Luther King on Monday, January 18<sup>th</sup> and that there was a virtual program as well. His report continued with statistics from the District Health Department COVID numbers from Monday, January 18<sup>th</sup> with Simpson County's total reaching 1,413 with 16 deaths and 1,189 recovered leaving just over 200 active cases. Vaccinations will continue this week with first responders and healthcare workers who received their first vaccine four weeks ago getting their second shot. Vaccine deliveries to the local health department and the Medical Center have been used mostly for first responders, healthcare workers and school personnel so thus far there has been limited availability to what should be the next phase of vaccinations for folks seventy and above. The quantity of vaccines received has been much less than expected by now and most local senior citizens are still trying to at least get on a waiting list. Information was given for senior citizens (70 and older) to text "SENIOR" to 270.796.3200 or email vaccine@mhealth.net to get their name on a waiting list for the vaccine at Bowling Green Medical Center if they have not yet been successful in getting on the local list.

Magistrate Chandler reported that the low water crossing at Trammel Creek in Allen County on KY 585 (Gold City Road) is closed for replacement due to public safety concerns. No date for the replacement was available.

Magistrate Downey reported from the Parks Board meeting that spring sports will take place but details were not yet available. He said that a virtual meeting was held by the Boys and Girls Club Board and reported there had been some staffing changes and that the board is seeking three to four new board members. A virtual Youth of the Year celebration is scheduled for January 26, 2021.

Jailer Vaughn reported that he had investigated and found that commissary funds could be used to pay employee wages for training hours and will be presenting a \$6,403.78 commissary check to be deposited for that purpose. Current inmate population included 191 state and five Adair County inmates.

Public Works Director Bobby Groves reported that he had contacted the district engineer to have an evaluation of Kenny Perry Bridge done.
