Approve the August 31, 2021 Financial Statement subject to audit and authorize signatures of Judge Executive Mason Barnes and Treasurer Nicole Law.

Judge Barnes reported that the next regular Fiscal Court meeting will be September 21st followed by a regularly scheduled joint meeting of the Franklin City Commission and Simpson County Fiscal Court at noon at the Historic Courthouse. He reminded department heads and elected officials as well as county employees of the protocol to contact KACo nurse triage for workers comp incidents so that claims can be initiated right away with first-hand information. It was noted that according to the Administrative Code 3.35 D any employee involved in an accident or worker's compensation injury shall be subject to a drug test and breath alcohol and/or blood alcohol test. There was also a discussion regarding the current guidelines with regard to employees' absenteeism due to COVID. Throughout the pandemic the county has continued to compensate employees due to COVID-related absences. After discussion involving court members as well as other elected officials and department heads with varying opinions being shared, the consensus of the court was to revisit this discussion in December.

Magistrate Thurman reported that Macedonia Road will be resurfaced by the end of the year with the approaches to the bridge to be smoothed during the project. Magistrate Chandler alerted folks to be aware of the presence of farm equipment on the roadways during this season and reported that the "NO PARKING" signs have not yet been set on Nashville Road in the area of the Tyson Foods facility.

Public Works Director Bobby Groves reported that following participation in a safety audit conducted by KYTC, new signage provided by the state and installed by Simpson County Public Works will be placed on Peden Mill (CR1137) and Roark (CR1006) roads.

Facilities Maintenance Supervisor Bill Rohrs reported that the coil to repair one of the HVAC units at the jail has arrived and will be installed as soon as weather permits.
