Sealed bids will be received by the Simpson County Fiscal Court until 10:00 AM CDT, Friday, March 13, 2020, at the office of the County Judge/Executive in the Historic Simpson County Courthouse at 100 Courthouse Square, P.O. Box 242, Franklin, KY 42135 for the resurfacing of Loving Chapel RD (2.24 miles). The project will follow the guidelines and specifications of the Kentucky Energy and Environment Cabinet's 2020 Waste Tire Rubberized Asphalt Grant. All material quality specifications shall be in conformance with Kentucky Highway Standard Specifications. Specifications may be obtained at the County Judge/Executive's Office, Monday through Friday from 8:00 a.m. until 4:00 PM or at www.simpsoncounty.us. The Simpson County Fiscal Court reserves the right to reject any or all bids. LOVING CHAPEL ROAD RESURFACING PROJECT 2020

NOTICE TO BIDDERS:

- Simpson County is seeking bids for the resurfacing of Loving Chapel Road, 2.24 miles in length, from KY 585 to KY 100. Bid shall include approximately 1,000 ton of Bituminous Concrete Surface, 1,000 ton of Rubber Modified Asphalt, delivery of material and application, tack oil, .05 gallon per square yard, heeling back of shoulders, including any necessary grade work to prepare for asphalt surface. The most responsive bid shall include the following specifications and requirements:
- Project shall comply with guidelines of the Kentucky Energy and Environment Cabinet 2020 Waste Tire Market Development Rubberized Asphalt Grant.
- Project shall be completed between July 1, 2020 and September 30, 2020, to be coordinated with the Simpson County Public Works Director.
- All items in this bid shall be constructed based on the Kentucky Transportation Cabinet's most recent standard specifications for road and bridge construction.
- All contractors and/or subcontractors shall be pre-qualified with the Kentucky Transportation Cabinet under work items C, C-1 & C-2 in order to bid bituminous paving projects with the Simpson County Fiscal Court.
- All materials required for this bid, including, but not limited to, Liquid Asphalt, Aggregates and Asphalt material for tack coat, must be from an approved Kentucky Transportation Cabinet source.
- Asphalt plant and site testing as required by the Kentucky Transportation Cabinet shall be provided at the contractor's expense, if requested by the Simpson County Fiscal Court. Testing shall be performed by a state qualified superpave technologist.
- Bids will be received at the office of the Simpson County Judge/Executive until 10:00 AM CDT, Friday, March 13, 2020. Award will be made on the basis of the lowest and best bid with the right to accept or reject any or all bids being expressly reserved.
- Award of this bid is contingent upon Simpson County Fiscal Court receiving the 2020 Rubberized Asphalt Grant from the Kentucky Energy and Environment Cabinet.
